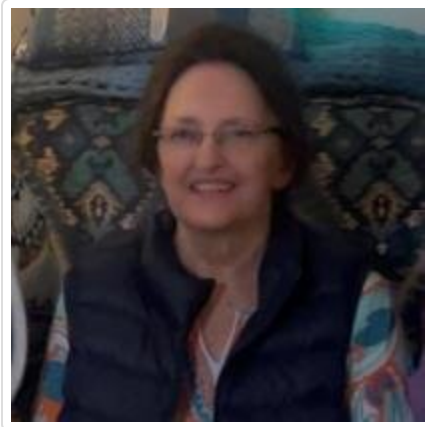




Phyllis Marline Blevins
