While in Bartlesville, Mrs. Edens worked at the Southern Abstract Company and the Washington County Tag Office. Mrs. Edens was a member of the East Cross United Methodist Church, the Dewey Eastern Star Chapter 312 and for the last few years she has attended the First Presbyterian Church at Sapulpa.
