Phyllis Eileen Vincent was born on June 20, 1920 in Norman, Oklahoma to James Leo Hughes and Belle Marie Brooks Hughes. She attended Stillwater Public Schools through high school graduating in 1937. She attended Oklahoma A & M (now Oklahoma State University) and graduated in 1941 with a Bachelor's Degree in Business. After graduation, she did secretarial work at Oklahoma Ordinance Works in Pryor, Oklahoma. In the spring of 1943, she joined the WAACS (Women's Auxiliary Army Corps) and proudly served her country for 32 months. She was stationed at Seabring, Florida and given rank of Sergeant. Phyllis was married to Patrick Grant Vincent on February 16, 1946 at the St. Francis Xavier Catholic Church in Stillwater. They enjoyed 60 years of marriage and raised a family of six children in Bartlesville. In 1967, Phyllis became a Licensed Practical Nurse through the nursing school at Jane Phillips Hospital and worked in a doctor's office until retirement in 1983.

Mrs. Vincent is survived by her brother James Leo Hughes and his wife Mauree Hughes of Houston, Texas.
