Mr. Ralph L. "R.L." Raemhild, 91, of Dewey, went to be with his Lord and Savior at 2:15 A.M. Saturday, March 21, 2015 at the Medicalodge in Dewey. Graveside funeral services for Mr. Raemhild will be held at 1 P.M. on Friday at the Memorial Park Cemetery with Rev. Ross Atkins of the Bartlesville Church of God officiating. Full military rites will be accorded by the Ceremonial Detail of the James H. Teel American Legion Post # 105. Services and interment are under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mr. Raemhild was born in Washington County, Oklahoma on December 29, 1923 to Floyd A. and Marie (Prather) Raemhild. He grew up and received his education in the Dewey area and graduated from Dewey High School. He was active in oil field work as a tool dresser until entering the U.S. Navy in April of 1943 and serving during World War II. Following his Honorable Discharge in March of 1946, he returned to Oklahoma and was married to Ethel Nadeen Cummins on May 17, 1947 at Sedan, Kansas. They made their home in the Dewey area all of their married life. He was again active in oil field work until his employment with Reda Pump Company where he remained until his retirement. He had a strong Christian faith, taught Sunday School and had been an active member at various times of the First Baptist Church in Dewey,

the First Church of God in Dewey and the Bartlesville Church of God. He was a wood carver, a taxidermist and an artist.

Mr. Raemhild is survived by his wife, Mrs. Nadeen Raemhild, one son, Terry Raemhild and his wife Kathleen of Reno, Nevada, one daughter, Janet Robinson and her husband Randy of Dewey, one sister, Ettabell House of Dewey, five grandchildren, Britt Robinson, Cody Robinson, Chad Raemhild, Kacy Wilson and Aaron Laughridge and four great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, two brothers and three sisters
