Dale was a product of the Havana education system graduating in 1954 where he served

four years on the Student Council and lettered in basketball and baseball and was a member

of the boys and mixed choruses. Dale was proud to have served in the United States Navy from

1954 to 1957 as Radarman Petty Officer third class. He was an active leader in Cub Scouts

and Boy Scouts and was the proud father of two Eagle Scouts and grandfather of one,

Shannon. He assisted with Laura's Girl Scout Troop and was affectionately known as the

"Cookie Monster" by the girls in the troop. Laura returned to college as an adult and earned degrees in Business and Accounting which was a great source in pride for Dad. The successes of his children and grandchildren gave him much pride in being their father. After the Navy Dale moved to Houston, TX where he married his children's mother, Carrol Jean Derrick. Carrol passed away in 2006. After their divorce in 1993 he married Sara Beth Newkirk and they moved to Denison in 1998 for retirement.

His lifelong curiosity led him to seek his family roots and he spent several years researching

his family genealogy. He located many unknown relatives and enjoyed getting to know them.

Born during the depression he experienced humility early in life, worked hard as a farm boy and

appreciated the strong work ethic he was taught and believed that anyone that worked as hard

as he did deserve to keep what they earned and that any task worth doing deserved one's best

efforts. Upon arrival in Houston his first job was as a car salesman where he was informed that

to be a successful salesman required a man to have larceny in his heart. He knew that would not

work for him and soon pursued the retail trade. After several pressure filled years, he left retail

for manufacturing and served 35 years as a metallurgical Heat-Treater at a Houston Aerospace

firm until retirement. He and Sara relocated to Denison upon retirement to enjoy small town life they so richly respected.

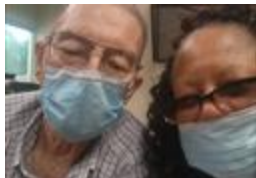
