Richard N. Knoblock, 89, passed away on Good Friday, April 18, 2014. He was born on September 27, 1924 in Tulsa, Oklahoma. He served our country in WWII in the Army and was a POW. Richard had a B.S. in Petroleum Engineering from the University of Tulsa and worked as a consulting engineer for various oil companies for many years.

Richard was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Bartlesville, Oklahoma, and had a strong and present faith. He was very active in the Salvation Army-Tulsa, in 2009 he received the lifetime membership award (50 years). Among his greatest joys were being a pilot and helping others. These paired perfectly in his dedication to the organization, Angel Flight, which flew cancer patients to various destinations for treatment. Richard loved people and had a wonderful sense of humor.
