Robert Gene Cameron, 75, resident of Tulsa, died Tuesday in Tulsa.

Graveside services will be held at 2:00 PM on Friday in the Ball Cemetery at Childers, Oklahoma, with Rev. Charles Cunningham of Oglesby Wesleyan Holiness Church officiating. Services will be directed by the Stumpff Nowata Funeral Home.

Robert Gene "Frog" Cameron was born July 17, 1936 at Nowata, Oklahoma to Paul Robert and Ruth LaVulla (Hurst) Cameron. He grew-up in Coffeyville, Kansas graduating high school from Field Kindley High School in 1954. Robert entered the U.S. Navy on February 24, 1955 and was honorably discharged on April 10, 1959. He worked for Beach Aircraft at Wichita, Kansas until beginning his career with North American Rockwell (Boeing) Aircraft in Tulsa. Robert worked for Boeing for thirty- four years. He was a member of the Pentecostal Holiness Church in Coffeyville, Kansas for several years. Robert enjoyed working with Appaloosa Horses.
