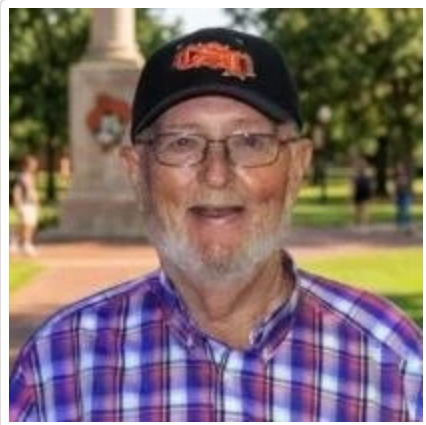




Roger Thomas Couch

Roger Thomas Couch, 77, of Bartlesville, Oklahoma, passed away Wednesday, May 6, 2026, at home.

Roger was born December 14, 1948, in Kansas City, MO to Rhea Roger Couch and Winona Mary (Gossett) Couch. He grew up in Bartlesville and graduated from College High School, Class of 1967.
