Roger and Sherry Pearsall were united in marriage on May 31, 1969. They were blessed and enjoyed 51 beautiful years together along with their children Jennifer and Chris. Roger was a teacher and football coach in Kansas and sold insurance in Coffeyville before he and his family settled in Bartlesville in 1979. Roger then went to work for Phillips Petroleum where he traveled overseas as a Facilities and Services Manager, Bartlesville Public Schools, and most recently Sodexo.
