Joe Everett “Smokey Joe” Quinton, 84, resident of Nowata, died Sunday at 8:00 PM in Bartlesville

Memorial services will be held at 2:00 PM on Saturday in the House of Prayer Church of the Baptized with Rev. Lawrence Green officiating. Visitation will be in the Stumpff-Nowata Funeral Home on Tuesday and Wednesday.

Joe Everett Quinton was born May 5, 1927 at Bartlesville, Oklahoma to Joe Alexander and Ethel Mary (Mills) Quinton. He was raised and received his education in country schools in the Talala and Winganon areas. He entered the U.S. Air Force on October 1, 1946 and was honorably discharged on August 23, 1949. Mr. Quinton was employed in Bridge Construction for over twenty-five years; he also built houses and worked in pipeline construction for several years. For the last fifteen years he has owned and operated Smokey Joe’s, building smokers and selling barbeque in Nowata. He was married to Sheryl Ann Pearce on August 18, 1989 at Grove, Oklahoma. Mr. Quinton was a member of the Elk’s Lodge and the Veteran’s of Foreign Wars at Nowata.
