On Christmas morning, December 25, 2018, Sue Ann Geissler living at Brookdale South in Bartlesville, Oklahoma completed her life's journey and her long courageous battle with Parkinson's and Parkinson's dementia. Sue was born October 5, 1936, in Santa Monica, California, to Richard B. Van Blaricom and Marjorie E. Kittle Van Blaricom.

While in Ruidoso, Sue developed a passion for playing tennis which she enjoyed playing for many years and resulted in her meeting and making many life long friends.

Sue left the Ruidoso area in 2003 after parting with Cap and moved to Keller, Texas where she later met and married her future husband, Rudy Geissler, with the wedding vows actually taking place during a hot air balloon flight.

Sue and Rudy moved to Bartlesville, Oklahoma in January 2007. Sue was an
