Mr. Terry Joe Gollier, 73, of Dewey, Oklahoma, died at 9:52 A.M. Wednesday, August 24, 2011 at the Jane Phillips Medical Center in Bartlesville.

Funeral services for Mr. Gollier will be held at 11 A.M. on Saturday, August 27, 2011 in the Stumpff Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Charles McKnight officiating. Funeral services and cremation arrangements are under the direction of the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.

Mr. Gollier was born at Independence, Kansas on September 4, 1937 to Dr. Charles E. and Jennie (Mitchell) Gollier. He grew up and received his education at Independence and graduated from high school there. He served in the United States military for a total of 12 years in the Army, Air Force and then in the U.S. Navy from October 1960 until receiving his Honorable Discharge in October of 1964. He was married to Mary Anne Williams in June of 1965 at Independence, Kansas. He was active in oil field work for a time and also worked at a service station in Parsons, Kansas. He later became involved in law enforcement working at Independence, Kansas, Caney, Kansas and Oswego, Kansas and was later a prison guard at the Conner Correctional Center in Hominy, Oklahoma. He was then employed with the Oklahoma State Transportation Department until his retirement due to ill

health in 1993. He came to the Bartlesville/Dewey area to make his home in 1986.

Survivors include his wife, Mrs. Mary Anne Gollier of Dewey, one son, Jeff Gollier and his wife Tina of Dewey, a sister, Cara Jane Bates, a grandson, Corey Ray Huffman and a great grandson, Braden Wayne Smith and a number of cousins. He was preceded in death by his parents.
