Farley L. Maple, "Tex", age 87, left his earthly home Wednesday, October 31st at his home in rural Delaware, Oklahoma surrounded by his loving family. Farley was born to Tom and Vera Maple on December 5, 1930 in Borger, Texas.

He attended Delaware schools. Farley served in the U.S. Army from 1950-1954. He was stationed in Greenland as a heavy equipment mechanic and operator.
