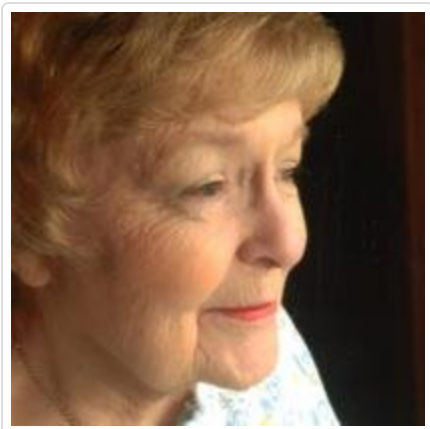




Thelma LaVerne Dunlap

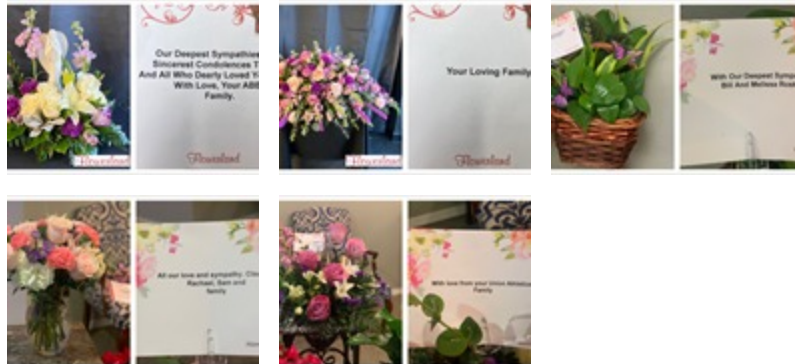
