Married to Greg Long on April 17th, 2010. They live in Owasso, Oklahoma. Tommy has been an active member of the United Methodist Church in Copan, Okla. Since December 21st, 1986. Since May 2011 He has been attended the United Methodist Church in Copan again.

He was diagnosed on April 27th, 2000 with Lung Cancer and it had spread to the bone. He took radiation treatments and chemo therapy both at the cancer treatment center in Tulsa, Okla.
