Greg Bordner, aged 67, passed away on Feb 23rd, 2015 after a long battle with cancer. A Memorial Service will be held at his church, Grace Community, on Saturday at 3pm. Service to be officiated by Dr. Rod MacIlvaine.

Greg was born on August 25th, 1947 in Lubbock Texas. He was the third and youngest child of Dusty and Emma Bordner. He graduated from the small Farm and Orchard community of Brewster in Washington State.

As a young man he obtained his pilot's license and embarked on lots of adventures and travels. On the north slope of Alaska he worked as a bush pilot and drilled water wells for remote Eskimo villages that had no running water.

Following that he began a long career in metal fabrication. He was considered by many to be a mechanical engineering genius. His keen mind and passionate work ethic lead to many innovative designs, and a lot of production deadlines successfully met.

Greg had an optimistic and adventurous spirit. He had a strong love for his work, his horses and animals, antique tractors, and his family and friends.

He is survived by two daughters, Michele and Lacy, son Zeke, nephew Bo, neice Chalena, his sister Lee, and his mother Emma.
