Vicki Rae Jesseph was born July 13, 1953 In Bartlesville, OK to Bob and Faye (Anderson) Stamps. She passed away November 18, 2015 surrounded by her family and friends in care of Bartlesville Care Center and Comforting Hands Hospice.

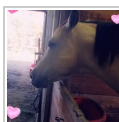

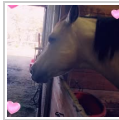
