Mrs. Virginia L. Dagley, 94, longtime Bartlesville resident, died at 4:00 P.M. on Monday, February 3, 2014 at the Green Tree Assisted Living Center in Sand Springs.

Mr. Dagley preceded her in death on November 20, 1997, and she continued her home in Bartlesville. She was a longtime member of the First Baptist Church where

she was active in decorating for different church activities for groups at the church, a member of the Young At Heart group and the WMU. She was also a longtime member of the Garden Club. Mrs. Dagley moved to Sand Springs to make her home near her children three years ago.
