THEY LATER MOVED TO WESTERN KANSAS AND THEN CHEROKEE, OKLAHOMA, TO CLAREMORE AND THEN TO THE COPAN AREA IN THE LATE 1960'S TO MAKE THEIR PERMANENT HOME. MRS GOODMAN HAD WORKED IN THE CHILD CARE NURSERY AT THE COPAN UNITED METHODIST CHURCH AND WAS ALSO THE NUMBER 1 VOLUNTEER AT HER GRANDDAUGHTER'S HEAD START PROGRAM IN BARTLESVILLE. SHE LOVED TO QUILT, WOODWORKING, GARDENING, CANNING FRUITS AND VEGETABLES AND ARTS AND CRAFTS. SHE ENJOYED LOVING ON HER GRANDBABIES. LOVED TENDING TO HER FLOWERS AND GARDENING SHE COULD CAN SOME MEAN GOODIES. SHE LOVED SITTING AND WATCHING THE HUMMINGBIRDS. IF IT WAS NICE OUTSIDE SHE WAS OUT THERE ENJOYING IT.
