Mr. Wayne E. Baker, 65, of Bartlesville, died at 9:55 P.M. on Sunday August 12th 2012, at his home in Bartlesville.

His hobbies were going to the lake, fishing, and spending time with his family and grandchildren, and he also enjoyed working on projects at his home. He was a man of great strength and character and had his priorities straight. He was a Shepherd of people and loved his God and his family.
