Mr. Wildon Rutherford, 91, of Ramona, died at 4:20 A.M. on Friday, April 10, 2015 at the Jane Phillips Medical Center.

Funeral services for Mr. Rutherford will be held at 10 A.M. on Thursday, April 16, 2015 at the First Baptist Church in Ramona. Interment will be in the Ramona Cemetery directed by the Stumpff Funeral Home & Crematory.
