William Boyd Owens, 41, resident of Wynona, died Friday in Bartlesville.

Memorial Graveside Services for Mr. Owens will be held at 2:00 P.M. on Thursday April 19, at the New Pavillion at the Ethel Reece Cemetery at Barnsdall, Oklahoma, under the direction of the Stumpff-Barnsdall Funeral Home.

Mr. Owens was born on October 12, 1970 at El Reno, Oklahoma to Oscar Lee and Ina Mae (Gaines) Owens. They came to Wynona, as he was a young boy, and he received his education there in Wynona Schools. Following his education he began his working life in the Oil field industry, working as a drilling rig hand for Spess Oil Co. He worked for Spess Oil Co. for a number of years, until going to work for the City of Barnsdall in the street department, and then later as a backhoe operator for the street and the cemetery departments, working there until 2007.

Mr. Owens was married to the former Carol Brixie on March 5, 2010 at Barnsdall at the Lighthouse Fellowship Church. They made their home in

Wynona for the past few years. His hobbies were fishing, and working outdoors, gardening and spending time with his family, and grandchildren, and his three dogs. He was saved as a young boy at the First Baptist Church in Wynona.

Mr. Owens is survived by his wife Neva Carol Owens, of the home in Wynona, one son; William Boyd Lee Owens Jr. of Wynona, by three step children; Suzanne Radford of Pawhuska, Devon Miller, of Wynona, and Skyler Davis, Hominy Oklahoma; by his Mother, Mrs. Ina Mae Owens of Wynona, by five brothers; Jerry Owens and Allen Owens of Wynona, Dan Owens and Ron Owens, of Pawhuska, and Larry Owens, of Hectorville, Oklahoma; by one sister Beverley Crowley, of Wynona, three grandchildren; Keylee Nicole Radford, and Kadie Bruce both of Pawhuska, and Zayden John of Hominy, Oklahoma.
