Willis R. Huston passed away May 14, 2012 at his son's home in Bartlesville, Oklahoma.

Willis was born April 8, 1922 to Walter and Ethel (Kerr) Huston of Americus, Kansas. He graduated from Americus High School in 1940. Willis was married to Helen Charlene Haucke on December 25, 1944 at Dunlap, Kansas. He was very active in the Swine and Cattle industry and was instrumental in establishing the Boar Test station in Kansas State University and carried on the registered Duroc business, which his father had established. He later became a fieldman for the Kansas Livestock Assn., from 1967-1972. After leaving KLA he raised registered Polled Herefords and Quarter Horses. He had retired from active ranching, but remained on the family farm until just recently.

Survivors include his wife of 67 years ; three sons, Steven, Randall and Harold and their wives. Also, five grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. There will be a graveside service Friday, May 25, 2012 at 2pm at the Americus Cemetery. After the services there will be a time of visiting at the Americus Presbyterian Church Annex.
